Re: House Bill 2105 - Northeastern Ecological Corridor


Dear Mr. Fraticelli:

Enclosed for your review is copy of a letter received on July 1, 2009, [REDACTED]

The letter details certain irregularities with the handling of House Bill 2105, which designated the Northeastern Ecological Corridor Natural Reserve in the coastal area of Luquillo and Fajardo. The bill was allegedly blocked in the Senate by then Senators Carlos Diaz and Jorge De Castro Font. Among the irregularities detailed in the letter is former Senate President Kenneth McClintock's approval of a recess requested by De Castro Font during the final hours of the last day of the Senate session. The bill, which would have affected the proposed projects of Costa Serena, San Miguel Resort and Dos Mares Resort was never voted on, despite the fact that it had overwhelming support.

Please advise if the FBI determines to investigate this potential public corruption matter, and whether it could result in a referral to this office for prosecution. Please contact Assistant U.S. Attorneys Ernesto Lopez Soltero and Jacqueline Novas for further details regarding this matter.
